



## Warneet Around French Island Race

Saturday 29 January 2022, on the waters of Westernport.

### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations Category 5 PLUS VHF transceiver.

Boats shall maintain a listening watch on the designated race management channel VHF 73 whilst on the water.

VHF transceivers may be hand held or permanently installed.

1.2. The person in charge of each boat entered must attend the pre-race safety briefing. It is recommended that all crew attend.

1.3. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the WMYC Clubhouse.

#### 2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. Entry is open to all boats complying with the Australian Trailable Yacht and Sports Boat Rule.

3.2. Enter by submitting the completed Entry Form and Payment **prior to** 09:00pm on Wednesday 26 January 2022.

3.3. Late entries will be accepted up to 8.00pm Friday 28 January 2022.

3.4. Entry in this race constitutes automatic entry into the Victorian Trailable Yacht & Sportsboat Traveller Series, at no additional cost.

3.5. FEES

3.6. The required fee is \$35 per boat.

3.7. An additional \$20 applies to entries received after 9:00pm, Wednesday 26 January 2022.

#### 4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Prior to racing, boats are required to register at the race office located at WMYC from 5.00pm on the night prior to the Race

4.2. Pre-Race Safety Briefing 8.00pm, on the night prior to the Race.

4.4. In the event of bad weather, the race may be rescheduled for Sunday 30 January 2022

## **7. SCORING**

- 7.1.** Races will be scored on Class Based Handicap (CBH).

## **8. PRIZES**

- 8.1.** Prizes will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> on CBH, for each division with three or more starters.
- 8.2.** Additional prizes may be given at the discretion of the organising authority.

## **9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 9.1.** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 11.2.** Entry fee includes BBQ on Friday night during the briefing and breakfast on Saturday morning.
- 11.3.** A two course Dinner during the presentation on Saturday evening shall be charged at \$20.00 pp
- 11.4.** Berthing on the South Jetty Pontoon will be available and designated moorings.  
A Water Taxi will be running from 5pm -10.30pm on Friday and from 5.15am Saturday.
